Baby To-Buy List

Here's a list of things you'll want to buy before your baby's arrival. My sister-in-law, Jennifer Lindenbaum, compiled this list. She's not only a busy lawyer but also a mom of my two beautiful nephews – Henry & Joseph.

- Disposable New Born Diapers (I DEFINITELY like Pampers Swadlers)
- Wipes – I like the seventh generation organic wipes
- Wipes warmer (I didn't use one) – but some people like it.
- Diaper Dekor (disposal system)
- Diaper Dekor refill bags
- Disposable changing pads to put on changing table –(very good in the beginning when baby is very messy – you put it on top of your changing table so you don't have to keep washing your changing table cover).
- Changing pad and cover
- Purel – (there are organic versions such as one called THE GERMINATOR)
- Tide or All FREE detergent, or Dreft.
- Aquafor – (use as a moisturizer)
- Balmex cream or Triple Paste
- Cotton Squares (like cotton balls) (they work great for wiping babies with just warm water before you use wipes or if baby is too sensitive for wipes)
- Sterile alcohol –(for cleaning thermometer)
- Baby Ayr saline nasal drops
- Bulb Syringe / Nasal Aspirator
- Calibrated dropper or spoon for giving medicine
- Infant Mylicon drops – for GAS – VERY USEFUL
- Baby wash / soap/Baby shampoo – I use Waleda – it is organic – get it at Whole Foods
- Infant or Baby Tylenol
- Infant or Baby Motrin
- Childrens' Benadryl
- Baby bathtub
- Baby healthcare set– make sure it includes rectal thermometer (if not, buy one) – also may include some of the things listed above.
- Breast pump

- Medela breast milk storage system
- Breast milk storage freezer bags –Lansinoh makes the best freezer bags
- Bottles – Dr. Brown’s bottles are BPA free and they fit directly onto the Medela breast pump and they are NOT glass.
- Boppy pillow for nursing (the better one for your back is “My Breast Friend”)
- Bottle brush (the softer the better so it doesn’t scratch)
- Bottle drying station
- Pacifiers (silicone, NOT latex).
- Baby monitor – I like the digital ones
- Crib pads
- Baby hangers
