

## **Questions a Patient Needs to Ask Their Surgeon**

- 1. What is my diagnosis?
- 2. What is the operation you are recommending?
- 3. How many of these operations have you done?
- 4. How long is the in-hospital recovery?
- 5. How long is the out of hospital recovery?
- 6. Will I need a transitional period with rehab or home nursing?
- 7. How long do you expect me to need prescription pain medication?
- 8. How long should I take off of work?
- 9. What are the risks?
- 10. Are there alternatives to this operation?
- 11. Is it worthwhile to seek a second opinion? (Any good surgeon will never discourage this.)
- 12. Who will oversee my care while I'm in the hospital?
- 13. Will there be residents operating on me? (This is fine, but it is good to know beforehand rather than be surprised at the group of 20-somethings at your bedside.)
- 14. What do I need to look for after the operation in terms of infection and wound healing and will I need sutures or staples removed?



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
